A wine that has a striking density of colour, which is crisp, medium bodied with dusty red fruits, subtle dried herbs, and wafts of vanilla and cedar in the background. Generous, plush with nicely judged acidity, leading to a soft seamless delivery and a gentle textural feel.

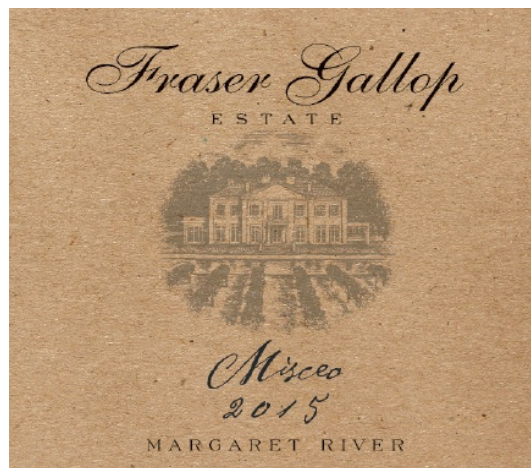
Winemaker Comments

We have always blended these varieties into our Cabernet Sauvignon, but they are so impressive as a group-of-four that they are now a stand alone entity.

Vintage

As a result of a very mild winter, our vines were tricked into thinking that Spring had arrived in August and therefore the growing season was ahead of a more traditional season. This factor combined with a difficult flowering season contributed to producing low yields and saw one of the earliest vintage starts recorded at Fraser Gallop Estate.

The summer months produced ideal weather, with mild temperatures, very little rain and strong winds, which kept the vineyard disease free. Resulting in exceptional flavour and balance across all varieties.
